

Indiana CANS & ANSA SuperUser/Trainer Certification Requirements

To become a CANS/ANSA SuperUser (Implementation Coach) or Trainer:

- 1) Prerequisite: current online certification for CANS and/or ANSA via the TCOM Training Website (<https://www.tcomtraining.com>)
 - Reliability score of .70 or higher
- 2) Participate in a Training for New CANS/ANSA SuperUsers (www.indianacansansatraining.eventbrite.com)
- 3) Complete, submit, and obtain Praed Foundation approval for the following small group activity worksheets via TCOM Training Website (within 2 weeks of training):
 - Write an introduction of the CANS/ANSA and TCOM (elevator speech)
 - Write domain level mini-vignettes (at least three domain items)
 - Write vignettes illustrating Key TCOM Principles
 - Write a vignette and provide ratings and rationales for items (national core items)
 - Complete an action (treatment) plan (optional for SuperUsers; required for Trainers)
- 4) Complete and submit online certification(s) for CANS and/or ANSA (dated within the last 12 months) via TCOM Training Website (within 2 weeks of training)
 - Trainers: reliability score of .80 or higher (for each utilized TCOM tool)
 - SuperUsers/Coaches: reliability score .75 or higher (for each utilized TCOM tool)

To Remain CANS/ANSA SuperUser (Implementation Coach) or Trainer:

- 1) Maintain annual online certification for CANS and/or ANSA via the TCOM Training Website (<https://www.tcomtraining.com>)
 - Trainers: reliability score of .80 or higher (for each utilized TCOM tool)
 - SuperUsers/Coaches: reliability score .75 or higher (for each utilized TCOM tool)
- 2) Participate in a CANS/ANSA SuperUser 'Booster' Workshop each state fiscal year (July 1 – June 30) (<http://www.indianacansansatraining.eventbrite.com>)
